ARTICLES of APPRENTICESHIP.

Sutton in Ashfield.

T H I S I N D E N T U R E made the 23rd. day of July one thousand nine hundred and nine BETWEEN THOMAS BROWN of Unwin Road Sutton in Ashfield in the County of Nottingham Glue Packer (hereinafter called "the father") of the first part WILLIAM EDWARD BROWN son of the said Thomas Brown (hereinafter called "the apprentice") of the second part and SAMUEL MEGGITT & SONS LIMITED whose registered office is situate at Hamilton Road Sutton in Ashfield aforesaid Glue Manufacturers (hereinafter called "the Company") of the 3rd part.

WITNESSETH as follows that is to say:-

1. The apprentice of his own free will and with the consent of the father hereby binds himself to serve the Company as their apprentice in the Fitting and Turning Department of their business of Glue Manufacturers now carried on by them at Hamilton Road Sutton in Ashfield aforesaid for the term of five years from the first day of December one thousand nine hundred and eight.

2. In consideration of the promises/^{the Company}covenant with the father and the apprentice and each of them severally as follows:-

(a) That they will accept the apprentice as their apprentice during the said term and will during the same term to the best of their power skill and knowledge instruct the apprentice or cause him to be instructed in the Fitting and Turning Department of their said business of Glue Manufacturers carried on by them at Hamilton Road Sutton in Ashfield aforesaid and in everything relating thereto.

(b) That they will pay to the apprentice every week during the said term wages at the rate of four shillings a week during the first year thereof and at the rate of six shillings a week during the second year thereof and at the rate of nine shillings a week during the third year thereof and at the rate of twelve shillings a week during the fourth year thereof and at the rate of fifteen shillings a week during the fifth and last year thereof.

3. The Father covenants with the Company as follows:-

(a) That the apprentice shall truly and faithfully during the said term serve the Company as their apprentice in the Fitting and Turning Department of their said business of Glue Manufacturers carried on by them at Hamilton Road Sutton in Ashfield aforesaid and at any other place where they may at any time during the said term carry on the same and shall diligently attend to the said business and at all times willingly obey the lawful commands of the Company and shall not absent himself from the Company's Service without the leave of the Company.

(b) That the apprentice shall not do or knowingly suffer any damage to be done to the goods or moneys or other things which shall be put into his custody or care and shall not embezzle or waste them or lend or dispose of them to any one without the Company's consent and shall not gamble with cards or dice or play at unlawful games or frequent taverns but that in all things he shall demean and behave himself to-

wards the Company as a good and faithful apprentice ought.

(c) That the father will during the said term provide the apprentice with suitable clothes good and sufficient board and lodging washing medical attendance and all other necessaries.

(d) That the Company shall be at liberty to deduct from time to time out of the wages to be paid to the apprentice as aforesaid any sum or sums of money which may be reasonable for any loss of time occasioned by the absence sickness or other incapacity to work of the apprentice and also for any loss which the Company may sustain by reason of the negligence or misconduct of the apprentice.

(e) That in case the apprentice shall at any time during the said term be willfully disobedient to the lawful orders or commands of the Company or be slothful or negligent or shall otherwise grossly misbehave himself towards the Company then and in any such case it shall be lawful for the Company to discharge the apprentice from their service.

IN WITNESS whereof the said parties to these presents of the first and second parts
